Principal's Report

Welcome back! I hope that the vacation was restful and re-energizing for all of you. As we settle into 2012, let me re-visit a couple of concerns.

The first is the **drop-off/pick-up** that is taking place adjacent to the Kinder playground. In spite of the painted curb (red no-parking) we are still dropping off and picking up our children from this area. MHPD has informed me that we should expect to be ticketed when this occurs. There are a few other traffic violations that are occurring as well. The officers will site those without further warnings. Please remember that for safety reasons, children must exit and enter their cars only after you pass the crosswalk. The only exception to this is when safety patrol is in place to assist students exiting the cars in the morning only. This will keep drivers focused so that people in the crosswalk are safe and allows the safety patrol to help your child. Please help us continue to keep your child safe by always pulling as far forward (as possible) in the traffic circle and following the directions of the teachers on duty and the students on safety patrol.

My other concern is attendance. Our tardy list has jumped significantly over the last few months. Many of these were not first time tardies. Being late starts your child's day off rushed and out of sorts. It also disturbs the learning in the early part of the morning and the teacher's efforts to get the class off to a smooth start. Your child depends on you to get him/her to school on time. Please help them to begin the day ready to succeed by having so a timely arrival. If a "morning emergency" happens (and we all know that, with families, some times they do) give us a call. Nevertheless, when your child is late, you must always accompany them to the office to receive a tardy slip and provide a reason for the tardy. Enlist your child's help in this New Year by having him/her choose clothes the night before and put all homework and books in a backpack or folder before they go to bed. The five to six minutes this saves you in the morning will make all the difference in

BoxTops & Labels for Education

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
