Project Cornerstone

Last month, our volunteer readers read "Say Something!" by Peggy Moss to Grades 1 - 6. The book's message to say something is a call to action for all of us to move from the passive role of bystander to the positive, active role of UP-stander. This lesson promotes many opportunities bystanders have to safely influence either the target or person with bully behaviors. By moving from a role of passive bystander to active UP-stander, kids feel personal power in their ability to positively contribute to a safe and caring school climate.

"Mr. Peabody's Apples" by Madonna is the Project Cornerstone book for January. This book will help demonstrate the destructive and hurtful nature of rumors and gossip. It will also show how quickly a person's good reputation can be damaged and how hard it is to repair.

In November, the Kindergarten readers presented "Talk and Work it Out" by Cheri J. Meiners. In this book, peaceful conflict resolution is simplified so children can learn to calm down, state the problem, listen and think of and try solutions. In January, the Kinder Readers will read "Accept and Value Each Person" by Cheri J. Meiners. This book introduces diversity and related concepts: respecting differences and appreciating people just the way they are.


