#### Principal's Report

Dear Paradise Valley Families,

When students miss extended time from school, no matter the reason, they are likely to fall behind in their schoolwork, decline in their academic performance, and loose their attachment or positive attitudes towards school. We can not close the achievement gap if our students are not in school. Also when students are absent from school, they are unable to receive the instructions necessary for them to be successful. Things do come up that make it necessary for students to miss school. Nevertheless, I know you will continue to do your best to get them here as well as get them here on time. Keep practicing that daily attendance habit. It is important that every student be in school every day.

Our After-school programs have begun and are in full swing. Please remember that attendance for these programs is especially important for your child. We ask you to please be on time to pick them up from the program. Also, please look for the announcement of our Saturday program that will begin within the next two weeks from now. We will continue to offer our Language Development Academy but plan to add a math club as well as a reading support program called Phono-Graphics. Upon receipt of the announcement, please return your child's permission slip as soon as possible. Placement in either of the programs will be assigned on a first-come, first-serve basis. The program will only be offered from 9:30am to 11:00am.

Interested parents should also look for an invitation to take part in a program called 'Engaging Parents as Asset Builders at School'. In this program, volunteers are prepared to read specially selected books and lead classroom activities and discussions that illustrate assets such as making healthy choices, peaceful conflict resolution, honesty and friendship skills. In addition to providing meaningful opportunities for parent engagement and for students to interact with caring adults the program helps create a common language for behavior expectations throughout the school. STAR testing begins April 5th and continues through April 21st


