



It is hard to believe that almost two-thirds of the year has come and gone already! As we end the second grading period (March 7th), I am happy to report that our positive behavior program is having an impact on our school's negative behaviors. I say this as our referrals have been on the decline for the past several months. To further our efforts in supporting this trend, we will begin our teacher training with Project Cornerstone (March 14th and 21st) as well as completing part II of the parent component to ensure we continue our efforts towards building the essential assets our children need today, tomorrow and in the future.

We are polishing up our skills in preparation for the CST test which will take place April 17th through May 14th (The fourth grade will take their CST Writing Test on Tuesday, March 6th). It is critical that your child is present on a daily basis for the pre-test preparation lessons that are geared to provide any needed support in the test areas they may be deficient in. We know our students are learning but they need to be here to prove that.

I need your help with another issue that seems to be a continuing problem as the year goes on: the morning drop-off and the pick-up process at dismissal time. The Safety Patrol and the teacher supervisors are out at the drive-through directing traffic and making every effort to keep your children safe. Most of the time, all 680 students get to and from their cars without incident and we want to keep it that way. Please remember that you need to pull up as far as you can in the drive-through before your child gets into or out of the car. No one is allowed to get out near the office because it backs up traffic onto the street. For obvious reasons, no student is allowed to get into a car that is stopped in the driving lane on the street. We ask teachers to lead their classes past the crosswalk with the expectation that up will pick up you child at the far end of the drive-through. Please show you support for their dedication and help them (Safety Patrol) to do this very important job.
