- Show your appreciation to our PV Teachers and Staff during the week of May 7 - 11th.



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## SCHOOL REQUIREMENT for incoming 7th Graders for Fall Semester, 2012

All incoming 7th graders must be vaccinated against pertusis (whooping cough) <u>by the first day of</u> <u>school.</u> Seventh graders will be required to show proof of a "**Tdap**" booster shot before starting school this Fall semester, 2012.

It is recommended that parents who currently have students in 6th grade, get their kids vaccinated well before the first day of school, Fall 2012. <u>There will</u> <u>be NO grace period and the regulation will be</u> <u>strictly enforced.</u> After your child receives their Tdap vaccine, bring your child's immunization record to the school office as proof they have received the vaccine.

To obtain a whooping cough/pertusis vaccination for your child, please see your regular health care provider. Immunizations may also be obtained at the Public Health Department.
