### **Principal's Report**

As we move into the change of seasons and the shortened daylight hours, I need your help in keeping our students safe.

Several students are late being picked up every day. If your child is on the playground after school, there are no adult supervisors watching to see that they don't get hurt. Please help us protect your child. Dismissal is 1:50 p.m. If you are delayed, please call the office so that we my let your child know. Students who are not picked up by 2:05, when the Safety Patrol go off duty, will be asked to come to the office and parents will be called. If one of your students is in extra help classes with his/her teacher, please pick up their sibling at the regular dismissal time.

Some of our students are riding bikes and skateboards to school without helmets. This is a violation of the traffic laws. Students are supposed to walk their bikes and skateboards once they pass through the back gate, or arrive at the traffic circle. We need your help in reinforcing the safety rules with your child.

Finally, when students miss extended periods of school, no matter the reason, they are likely to fall behind in their school work, have a decline in their academic performance, and lose their attachment or positive attitudes toward school.

According to Ed. Code 48260, any pupil who is absent from school without a valid excuse three (3) full days in one school year or tardy or absent for more than any 30 minute period during the school day without a valid excuse on three (3) occasions in one school year, or any combination thereof is truant and shall be reported to the school attendance supervisor (principal) which could lead to a referral to the district Truancy Abatement Program (SARB).

As always, I thank you for your help in supporting the teachers, myself and most importantly our students in these very important areas.


