### 🗳 Principal's Report

As we move into the change of seasons and the shortened daylight hours, I need your help in keeping our students safe. I have a few areas of concern:

Several students are late being picked up every day. Dismissal is at 2:05 p.m. on Mondays, Tuesdays, Thursdays and Fridays. On Wednesdays, school dismissal is at 12:50 p.m. If you are delayed, please call the office so that we may let your child know. Our teachers and Safety Patrol go off duty at 2:20 p.m. Parents who are late for pick up, will need to come into the office to pick up their child and sign them out.

My second concern is that our parents are entering our pick up area at an unsafe speed. Please help us to keep your children safe by reducing your speed to 5 mph as you initially enter the pick up drive through. As always, please continue to move forward as far as possible to accommodate the other vehicles behind you. It is also extremely unsafe to have our children exit vehicles along the fenced area as you first enter the drive through. Thank you for your help with this and in keeping our arrival and exit areas safe.

Finally, students (as well as parents and siblings) are supposed to walk their bikes scooters, and skateboards upon entering or exiting our school. We need your help in reinforcing the safety rules with your child.

As always, I thank you for your supporting the teachers and myself in this very important area. We want all our families to be healthy for the approaching holiday season.
