Dear Paradise Valley Families,

Collaboration among teachers at Paradise Valley is leading the way for our instructional practices to improve. By design, this process can offer support and motivation to our teachers as they work to overcome the tight resources, isolation, time constraints and other obstacles they commonly encounter here at Paradise Valley. Our teachers are working collectively to set and enforce standards of instruction and learning. There are five critical elements that encompass our collaboration. They are: 1) reflective dialogue; 2) de-privatization of practice; 3) collective focus on student learning; 4) collaboration; and, 5) shared norms and values. As you are aware, we have re-structured many conditions in order to meet the requirements. We have time to meet and talk (every Wednesday) and we have improved the physical proximity as we all meet together in the library. In addition, we have created interdependent teaching roles, that is, we have recurring formal situations in which teachers work together (team teaching) and regular meetings, or a mail system that provides a network for the exchanges of ideas on instruction, curriculum, assessments, and other professional issues. Lastly, we are developing the flexibility that allows our teachers to respond to the specific needs they see in our students. More updates to follow.

On a final note, please reduce your speed as you proceed into the drive-thru at all times. Also, remember to continue being courteous by alternating with the car turning before you into the drive-thru. Remember, SAFETY FIRST!

Our Home and School Association sponsors an incentive program for good behavior for all students at Paradise Valley. The program was initiated and implemented two years ago by Principal Phil Duncan. The goal of the program is to create a culture of safe, responsible, and respectful children. Students earn Panther Pride tickets from campus staff members when they are "caught" being safe, being responsible, and being respectful toward others. Once the students earn tickets, they have an opportunity to "shop" at the Panther Den. This store provides prizes in exchange for earned tickets. Parent volunteers keep the store stocked with prizes and schedule shopping times. This happens about every two weeks during the students' morning recess times, and will be held on Fridays.
