# **Principal's Report**

Welcome to the 2009-2010 school year. Our opening day was filled with excitement and plenty of smiles. Students, staff and parents were very pleased to see each other as our campus seemed to come back to life due to the excitement and emotions that come with beginning of a new school year at Paradise Valley Elementary School.

You will notice that we have added several new staff members: Ms. Nahrain Nona in third grade, Ms. Carrie Williams in second grade, Ms. Janel Bolze in fifth grade and Mrs. Doting in the third grade (Substitute for Mrs. Jean Mason). 
