

HSA meeting August 27, 2020

- Meeting called to order at 7:04 PM (Jodi Hall)
- Review of 2019-2020 financials (Carmen Patrick)
 - Motion to approve - Denise David
 - Second to approve - Jodi Hall
 - Financials approved
- Propose budget for the 2020-2021 school year (Carmen Patrick)
 - 4th and 5th grade fundraising is still up in the air based on if the science camp and Sacramento trips happen
 - All funds raised by 4th grade this year will go into their class fund, if they are unused this year for Sacramento, they will carry over to next year to be used for science camp
 - 5th grade - all funds raised last year for Sacramento have been moved to their science camp fund this year. Any additional funds that they raise this year will go into their class fund and used if we able to send them to camp this year
 - Mrs. Bonino is looking at the logistics of taking 4th grade to Sacramento this year, currently scheduled to go in February. It has been proposed that we try to move it to later in the spring, she will check on this.
 - If science camp and Sacramento aren't able to happen this year, Carmen will work on getting our deposits back.
